

# **BUFF-TAILED BEE INFO FOR PARENTS**

## WHAT EACH CHILD WILL NEED

In the video, Groovy Su will take you through an example of how she made a buff-tailed bee.

You can make your bee using **any materials you have in the house**, so you don't need to use exactly what Su uses.

**We recommend gathering:**

- **A plastic bottle**
- **Plastic bags** for covering – ideally black (like a bin bag), white and yellow. Some paper coloured in yellow can replace a yellow bag if you don't have one.
- **Clear plastic food container** for the wings
- **Rubber bands or pieces of string**
- **Anything else that looks interesting** – bottle caps, old fabric, bubble wrap, scraps of plastic from food containers etc!

These are things that artist Groovy Su uses to embellish her bee:

- **Bubble wrap** or plastic bags for padding.
- An old **black sock** for the face
- **Yellow fabric** (could be a sock!)
- **Yellow and black wool**
- **Black plastic food container**
- **Bottle caps**

Tools its useful to have to hand are:

- **Sellotape**
- **Scissors**
- **A marker pen** if you have one





**This project can be undertaken by a child without specific adult assistance.**

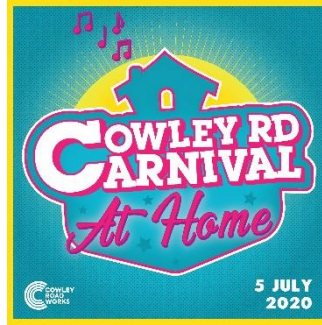
